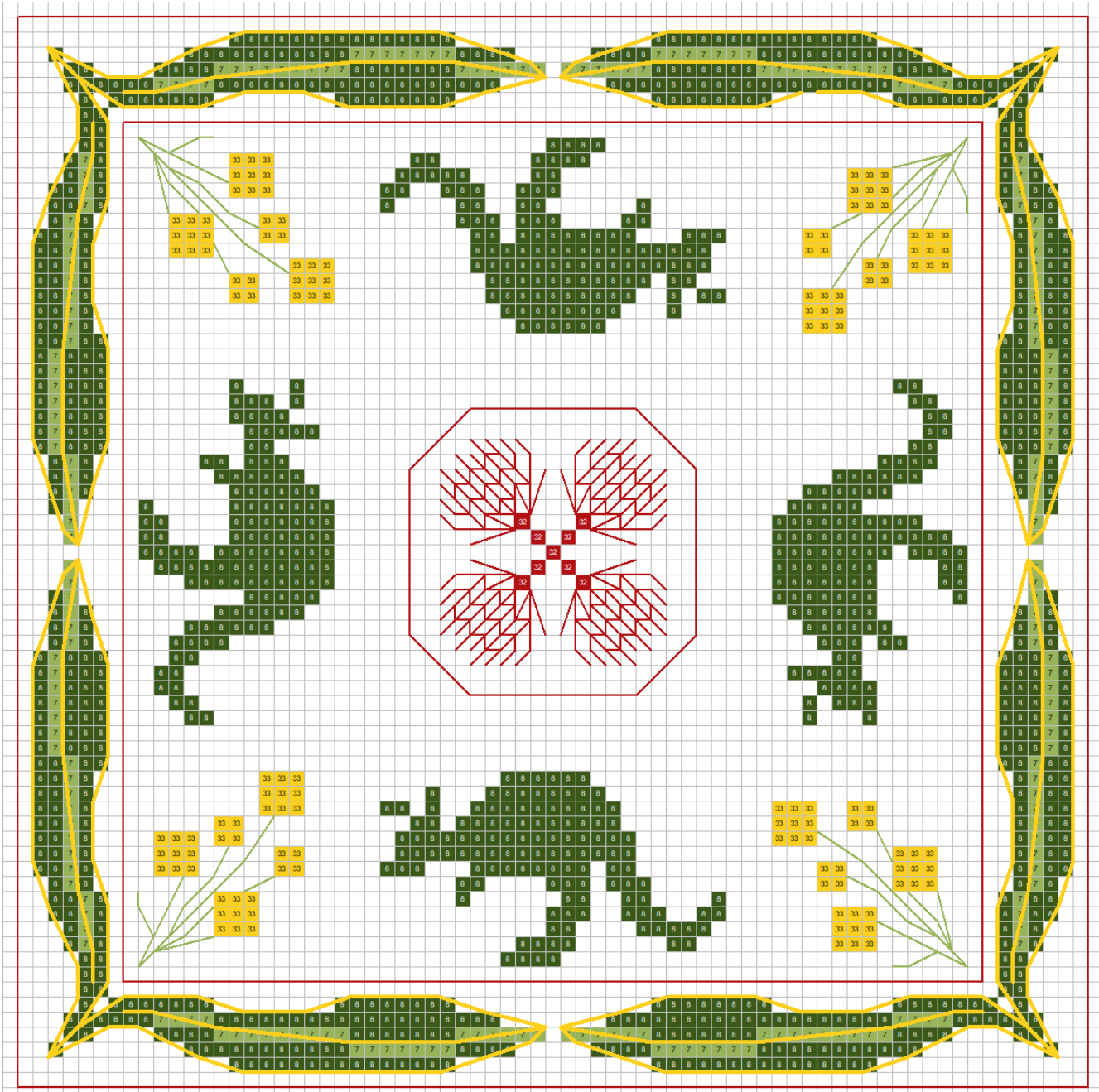




BISCORN-ROO

FABRIC

18 count tea stained aida

STITCH GUIDE

1 Strand

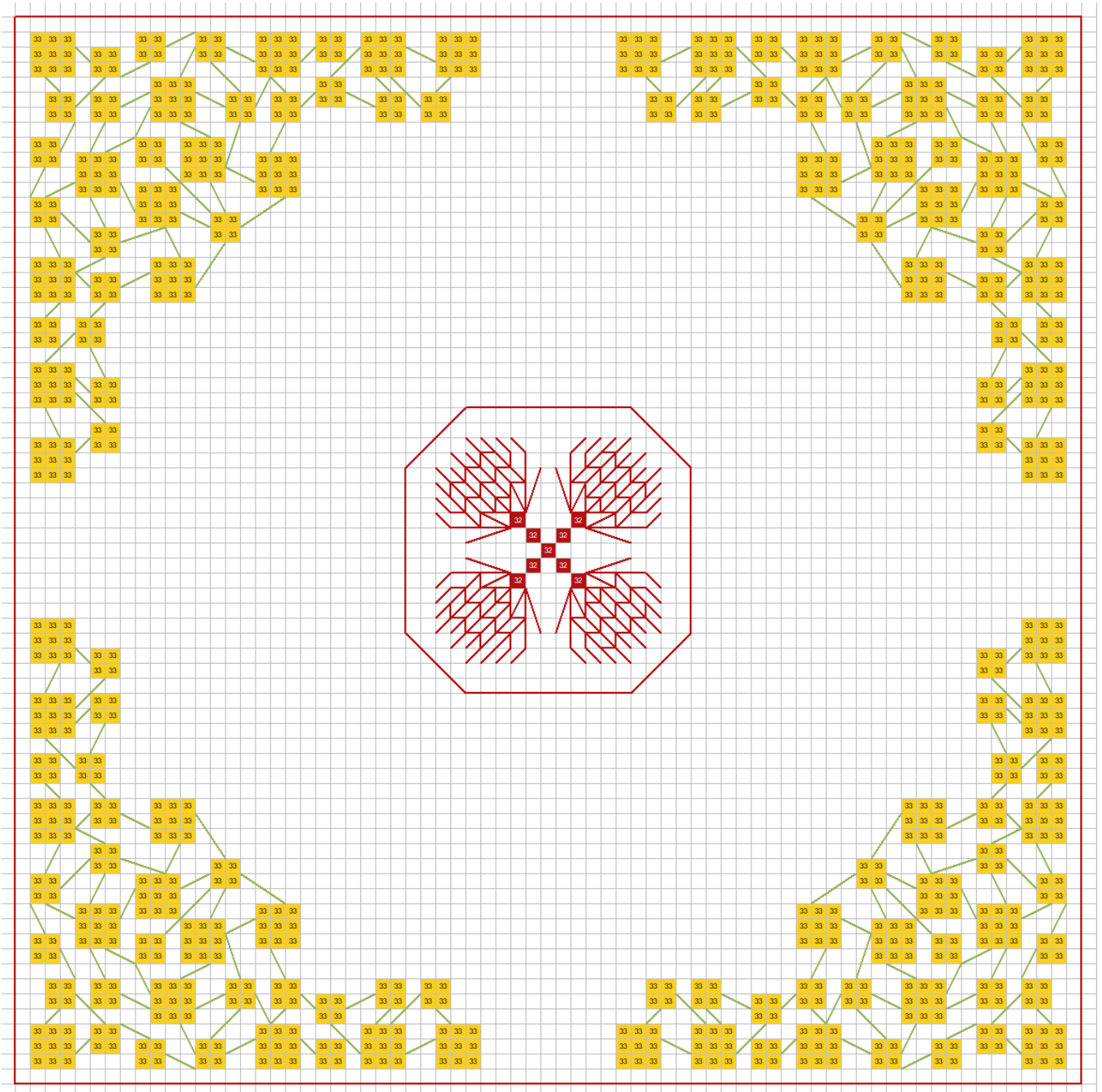
Stitch count: 71 x 71 and 71 x 71

9	CGT LM23 Spruce
7	CGT 801 Salvia
33	CGT 316 Buttercup
32	CGT 1007 Hugs n Kisses

Backstitch

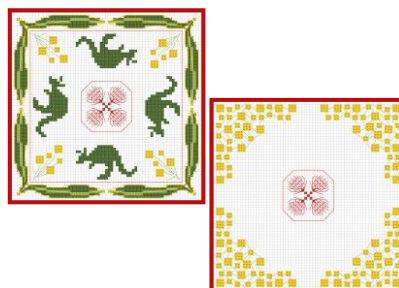
Gum leaves	CGT 316 Buttercup
Wattle	CGT 801 Salvia
Waratah	CGT 1007 Hugs n Kisses





FINISHING

- Trim fabric leaving a 1/2 inch border.
- Offset squares, lining up one corner to the middle of the other square.
- Whip stitch together catching only the backstitch - leave a section open.



- Fill with desired stuffing, then whip stitch closed.
- Using 2 small red shank buttons, pull in centre of biscornu by sewing both buttons with the same length of strong thread and pull tight before securing.
